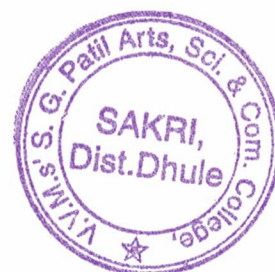
4.1.7 To create a variety of types of feedback mechanisms to promote colleges to go for better governance.

- To conduct Academic and Administrative audits.



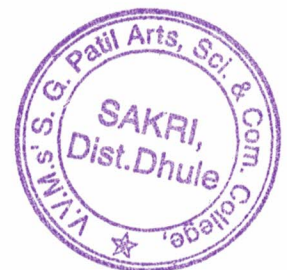
